Guidelines:

- Career Account Funding is available for prospective participants who are planning to enroll, or who are currently enrolled in courses or programs of study leading to a career in the Homeland Security related professions:

Police Science Technology, Corrections and Forensics	Fire Science
Networking Administration & Security	Emergency Medical Services
Emergency & Disaster Management	Cyber Crime Investigations
- Individuals may receive financial aid from other sources and still be eligible to apply for the CBJTG Career Account. Individuals are ineligible for the CBJTG Career Account if receiving Workforce Investment Act funding toward their tuition & fees.

- For those seeking short-term training or a certificate program, CBJTG Career Advancement Account funds will cover tuition & fees up to a maximum cap of \$3,000 per participant.
For those pursuing a diploma or associate of applied science degree, CBJTG Career Jump Start Account funds will cover the cost of tuition and fees up to \$1,500 per semester for up to four (4) semesters, with a maximum cap of \$6,000 per participant.
The cost of textbooks and supplies will be the responsibility of the student.
- All in-state and out-of-state applicants are eligible to apply for CBJTG Career Accounts.
- If a class is dropped or failed, the Career Account recipient is expected to reimburse the CBJTG program. Funds may not be used for tuition and fees to retake the same class.

Selection Process:

- Career Account awards will be based on academic performance and career plans, not based on income.
- Prospective CBJTG-funded training participants must complete an 8-hour Business Fundamentals “Career Bridging” Workshop and complete a Career Education Plan. The plan, as well as a completed CBJTG Career Account application, must be turned in to The Security Institute at least one week prior to the first class meeting.
